Sun City West Foundation is a non-profit corporation established to promote and support charitable, educational and service activities and organizations that service our community. Our Helping Hands division serves over 15,000 people annually loaning medical and children's equipment. Prides receive warehouse and office space, with water and trash included, for \$1/year. AARP tax-aide is provided free facility use to provide free tax preparation to our residents. Relay for Life, Northwest County Fire and Medical District and Community Fund SCW receive free meeting rooms.

SCW Foundation partners with Sun Health Resale Shop, receiving proceeds from the shop in lieu of rent. We provide significant financial support to Northwest Valley Connect transportation programs, give free storage to American Legion Post 94 for their Blvd of Flags program and we accept old flags for proper retirement. A member of Sun City West Consortium, SCW Foundation is also an American Red Cross Emergency Shelter. An independent non-profit corporation, SCW Foundation receives no funding from the dues you pay to the Rec Centers, but relies on your tax-deductible donations.
