MARCH 8, 2010- SUN CITY WEST welcomes VALLEY METRO BUS. Valley Metro is now here for YOU!!

Valley Metro Route 660, a rural connector bus route that travels between Surprise, Wickenburg & the Arrowhead Towne Center on weekdays and Saturdays now stops at the Sun City West Foundation at 14465 R.H. Johnson Blvd. The bus stop was added to provide transportation for Sun City West residents that want to go to the Arrowhead Towne Center or Wickenburg for shopping & social activities. Also, this service is convenient for passengers making local trips between Grand Ave & Bell Rd. Route 660 buses can carry up to 16 passengers & is completely accessible to persons with disabilities. If you drive..park at the SCW Foundation & hop on the 660. If you don't drive, call the SCW Foundation bus to get to the new bus stop. Free transfers are available between Route 660 & the SCW Foundation bus service. Advance reservations are required for the SCW Foundation service; call 623-544-3020. Route 660 will also provide flexible stops, where you choose your own pick-up & drop-off location up to three quarter mile from the regular route. This requires a one-day advance notice.
